

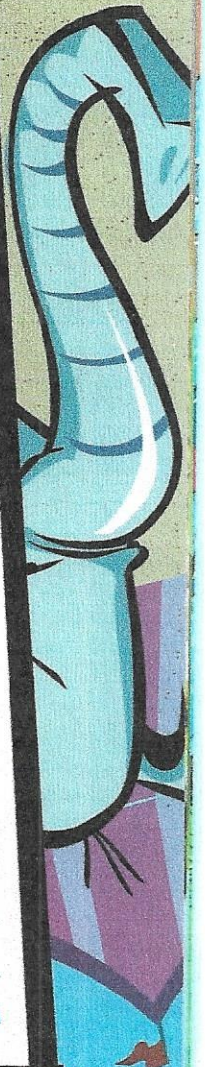
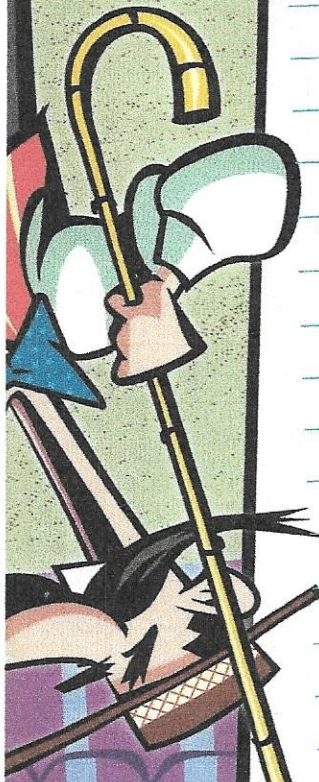
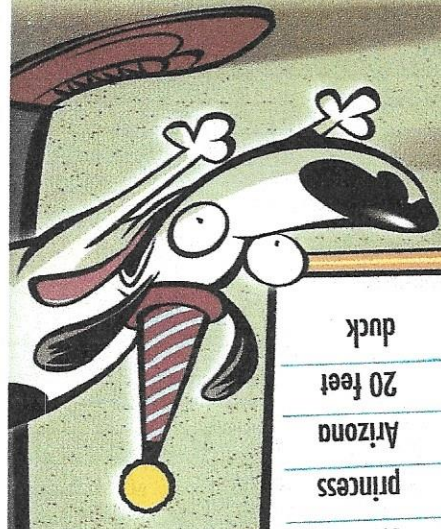
Ring the Bell
