with feathers beige and brown.

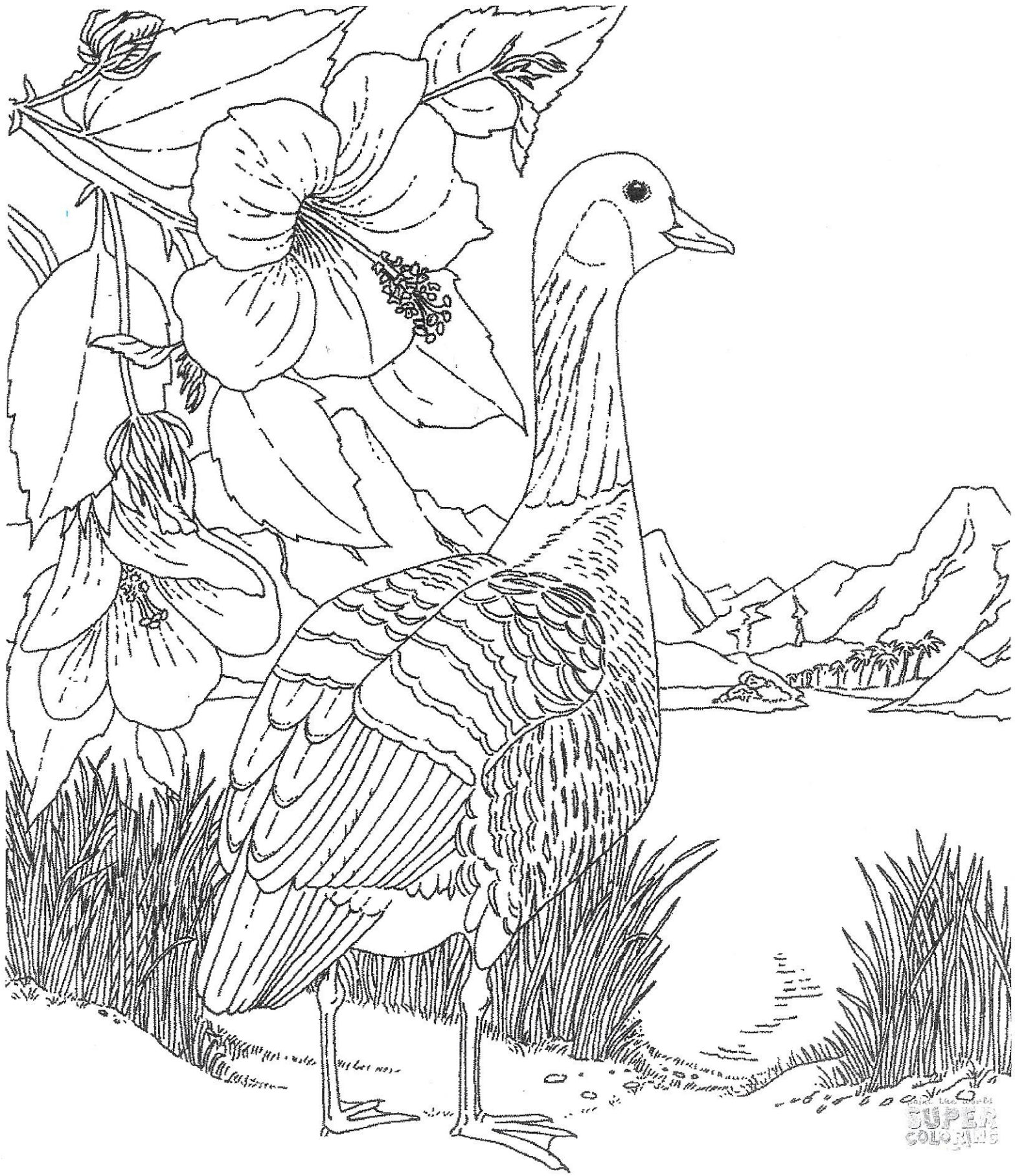
It lives atop the great volcanoes

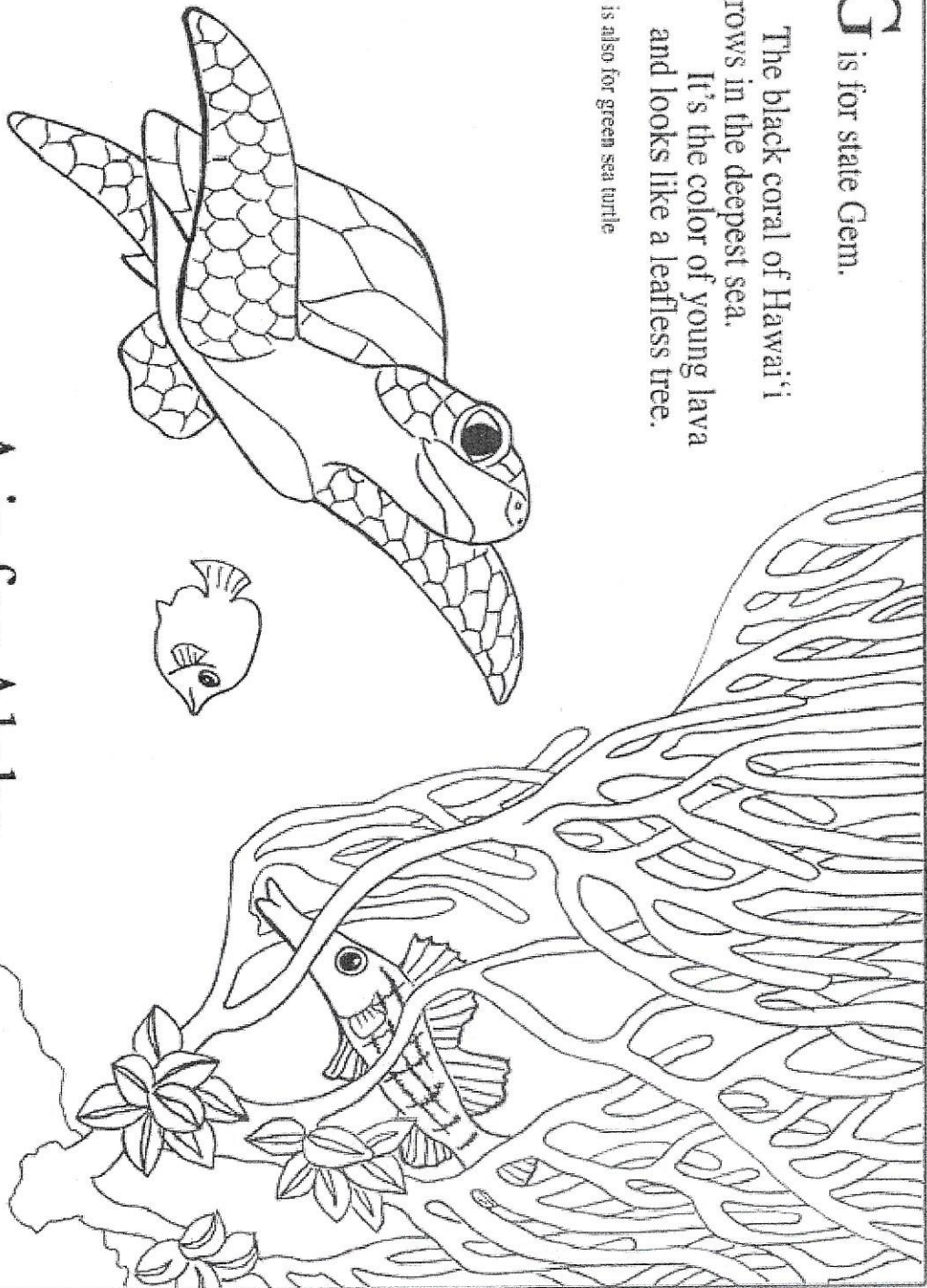

and looks like a leafless tree.

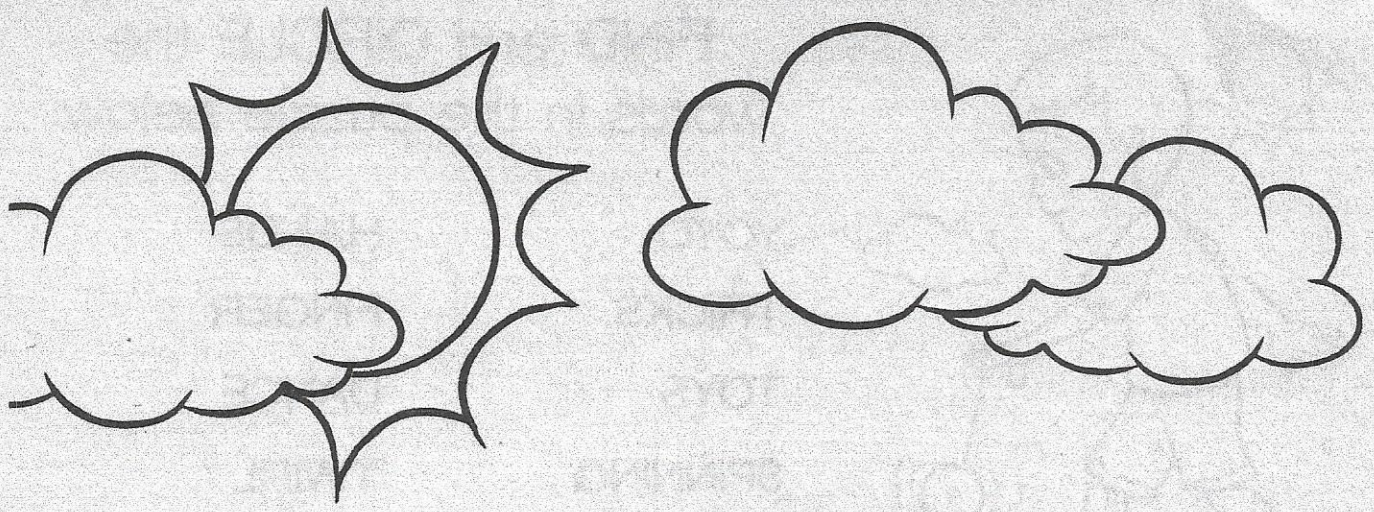
