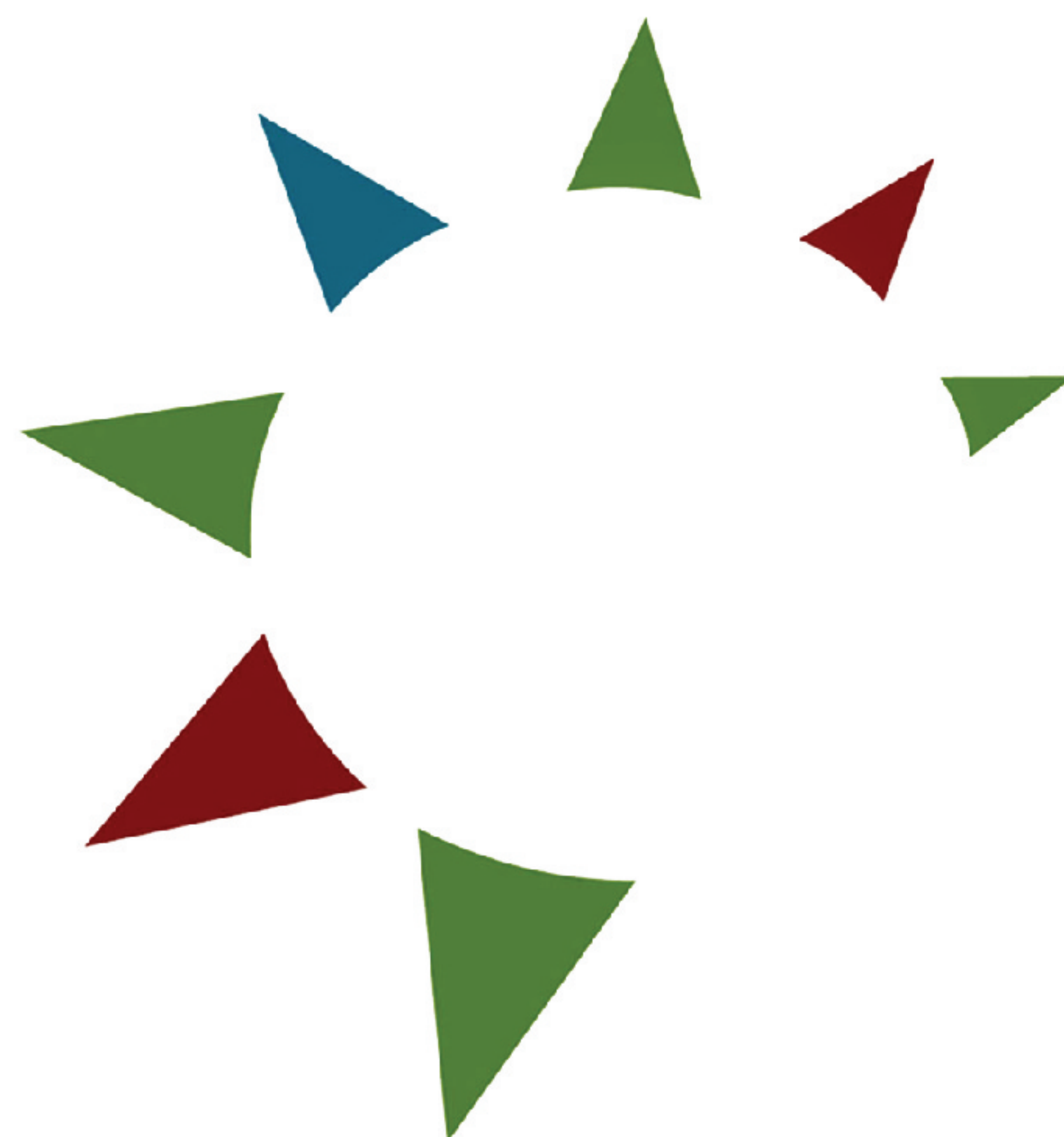

Nursery care and religious education (RE) classes for children (ages Pre-K to 12th grade) occur during the services. On the first Sunday of each month, children start in the sanctuary with their parents for a Story for All Ages; otherwise, they start in the classrooms on the lower level.

You're welcome to keep your child with you in the Sanctuary, or you are able to stay with your child in their RE classroom, ask about ways the technology available to experience the service from the classrooms!

Deepening our connection the sacred, and becoming more fully aware of the expanse of our own souls, is the work of Adult Spiritual Development. In the process we grow closer to one another, and closer to that "transcendent mystery and wonder" that is at the core of human existence.
